

Policy: Unaccompanied Adults in Youth Areas

The Children's Library is reserved for use by children, their parents or caregivers, and patrons using the children's collections. Adults and teens unaccompanied by a child may enter the Children's Library to obtain books or other materials but extended browsing or sitting in the Children's Library by unaccompanied adults and teens is not allowed and the unaccompanied teen or adult will be asked to leave the area.

Use of restrooms in the Children's Library is restricted to children and their parents or caregivers or those using the children's collection. All others must use the restrooms in other areas of the library.

The Teen Center is reserved for use by teens in middle school and high school, their parents or caregivers, and patrons using the space for scheduled programs. Any unaccompanied adult who enters the Teen Center who is not there with the purpose of conducting business with the Teen Librarian will be asked to leave the area.
