The Bristol Public Library uses various social media sites to promote library activities and to provide informational content. The library welcomes public involvement with the library via social media, as it provides the library with valuable feedback and community information.

Public comments will be reviewed by the library for relevancy and appropriateness. The library reserves the right to remove any inappropriate or irrelevant postings. Examples of inappropriate or irrelevant postings are included below and are not intended to be an exhaustive list.

- Obscene or racist content
- Personal attacks, insults, or threatening language
- Potentially libelous statements
- Plagiarized or copy-written material
- Violation of intellectual property rights
- Private, personal information published without consent
- Comments totally unrelated to the content of the forum
- Hyperlinks to material that is not directly related to the discussion
- Commercial promotions or spam
- Organized political activity
- Photos or other images that fall in any of the above categories.

Any comments or concerns regarding a social media posting should be directed to the Executive Director. Final determination on the appropriateness of a posting or comment will be made by the Executive Director.
