GIESLER-DEVAULT CEMETERY

Located Southwest from Bristol on TN. Highway 11-E to Piney Flats. At the main intersection in Piney Flats turn right at the traffic light, then turn right at Hicks Road and after a short distance turn left on Lowell Jones Road, proceed approx. 500 yards and turn into a downhill driveway on the right after passing a large red barn on the left. Cemetery is on the hillside behind a large, white, abandoned farmhouse owned by Harry CROWE.

According to a family source, Rev. Henry GIESLER was killed in the Civil War. his father, Adam GIESLER married Mary DeVAULT, daughter of Gabriel DeVAULT, who is buried in the same Cemetery. Adam GIESLER's brother, Jacob GIESLER, Sr., is buried in the Boy Cemetery, surveyed and published in a previous issue of the HOLSTON PASTFINDER.
