

CEMETERY RECORDS - WASHINGTON COUNTY, VA.

IRESON/SWINGLE CEMETERY

Located in Washington Co., VA about 7 miles North of Abingdon in Rich Valley in an area called Low Lands on VA. Road 824. There were about 20 tombstones scattered around; some were leaning against the trees, others were buried in the ground, while others were broken and sliding down the hill. Cows were lying on some. Only 5 stones were legible. There were two graves enclosed within a fence; the two large native stones at the head were illegible. It is believed that this is the final resting place of Michael SWINGLE (1759-1827) & wife, Mary "Polly" CUMMINGS (1771-1847), dau. of Rev. Charles CUMMINGS; James IRESON, Sr. (1792-1866) & wife Mary Anna SWINGLE (1796-1872) & their dau. Letitia IRESON HILL (1828-1885). This Cemetery is located on the SWINGLE/IRESON land.
