

SNODGRASS CEMETERY

Located approx. 2 miles South of Bristol on TN. Highway 126 on the right near a private residence whose driveway is access to the Cemetery which is surrounded by evergreen trees and situated just prior to an intersection with Cardon Hollow Road.

Interred herein are A. W. TAYLOR and his sister, Mary Alice TAYLOR DAVIS, whose maternal Uncle, William HUMPHREY, is the most controversial and disputed historical character in American History due to the claim that he received a Mexican Land Grant in Nacogdoches, Texas, Feb. 14, 1835. Because of his interest in the Spindletop Oilwell Controversy in the early 1940's, A. W. TAYLOR researched the family tree of his mother Matilda HUMPHREY TAYLOR. He remained undaunted until his death concerning the alleged historical attribute of his Uncle William HUMPHREY.
