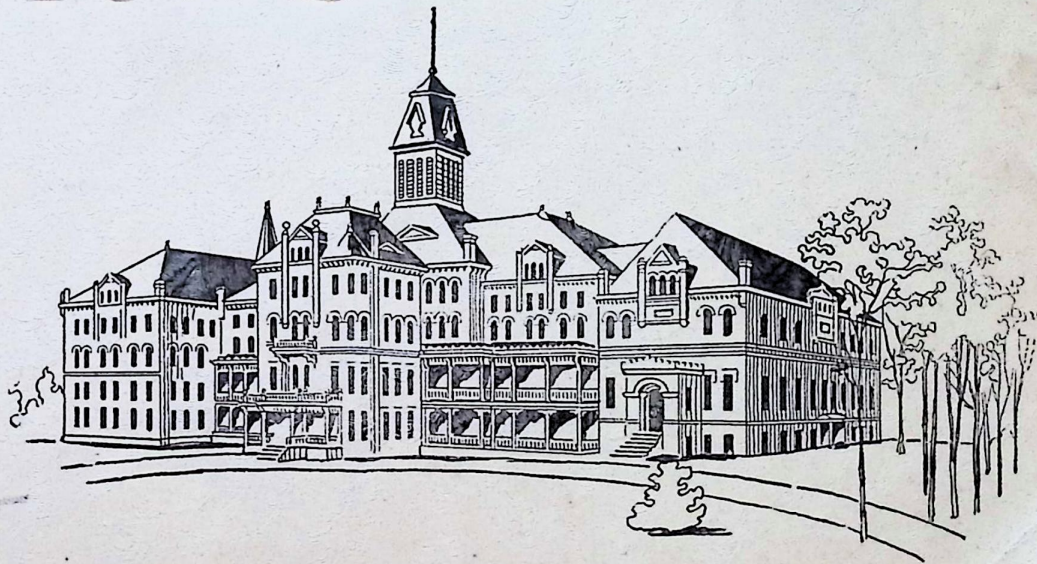

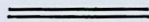

Some Features Which Contribute to Its Success and Crowd the School to Its Capacity Every Session:

FIRST.—The delightful, invigorating climate, the same general health conditions as those of Asheville, N. C. Altitude, 1900 feet. Among the mountains, "Intermont."

SECOND.—The beauty of the location and the excellence of the property, which is worth \$160,000.00, with not a cent of indebtedness.

THIRD.—The strength of the faculty. All teachers are College or University graduates of broad experience. The faculty makes the school.

FOURTH.—The standardized courses of study. For six years the school has been a standard Junior College. This is a day of standards.

FIFTH.—The special courses in Music, Art, Expression and Domestic Science. Intermont is widely known for its strong musical advantages. Prof. Schroetter has been Director of Music for twelve years. NINTH.—The cosmopolitan character of the patronage. Students come to Intermont from all parts of the United States, and from foreign countries. The cultural and broadening value of the environment is most helpful.

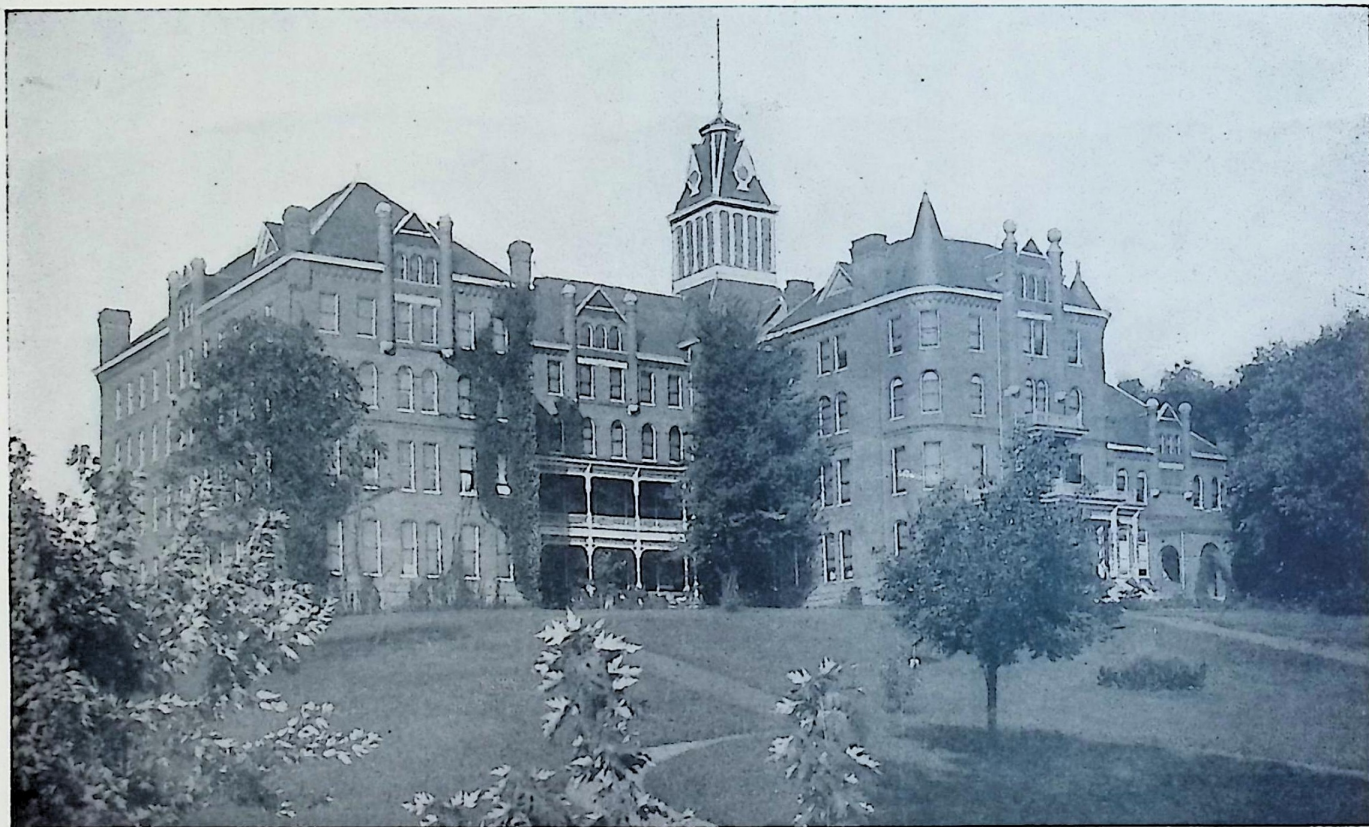
TENTH.—The moderate terms. The purpose of the school is to serve, not to make money.

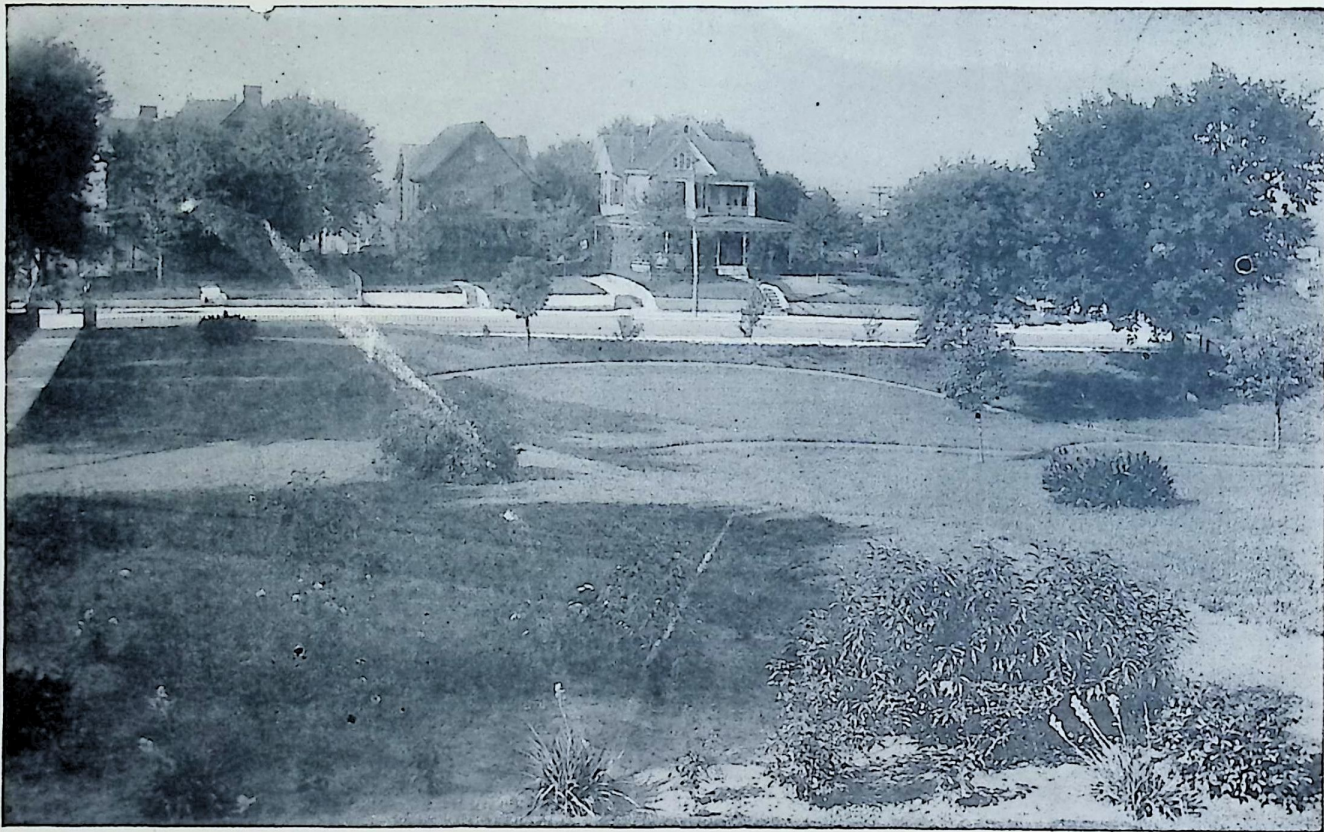
FOURTEENTH.—The social feature. This is sufficiently emphasized to bring out and develop the social graces for which the Intermont girls are noted.



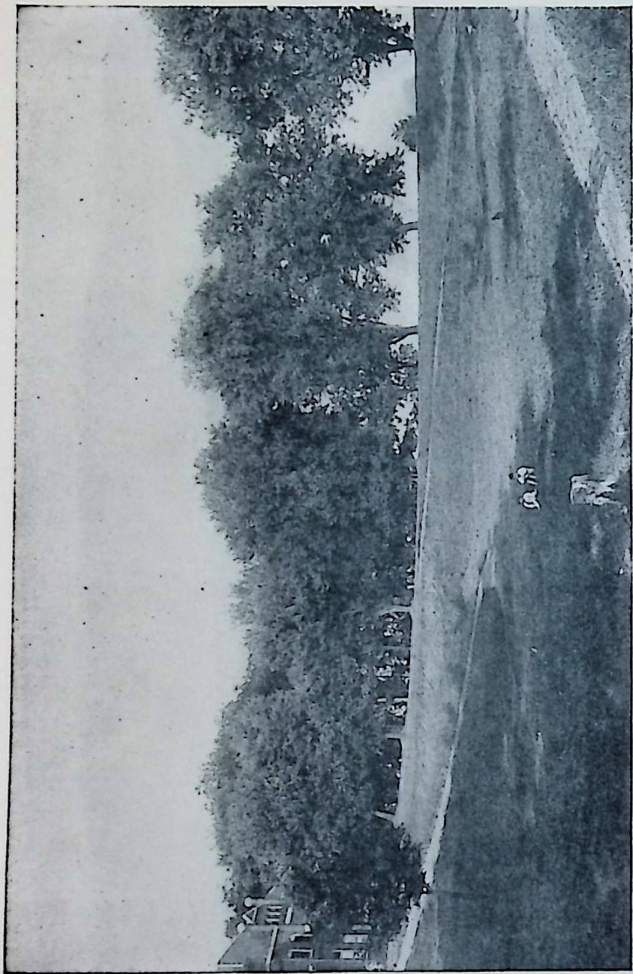

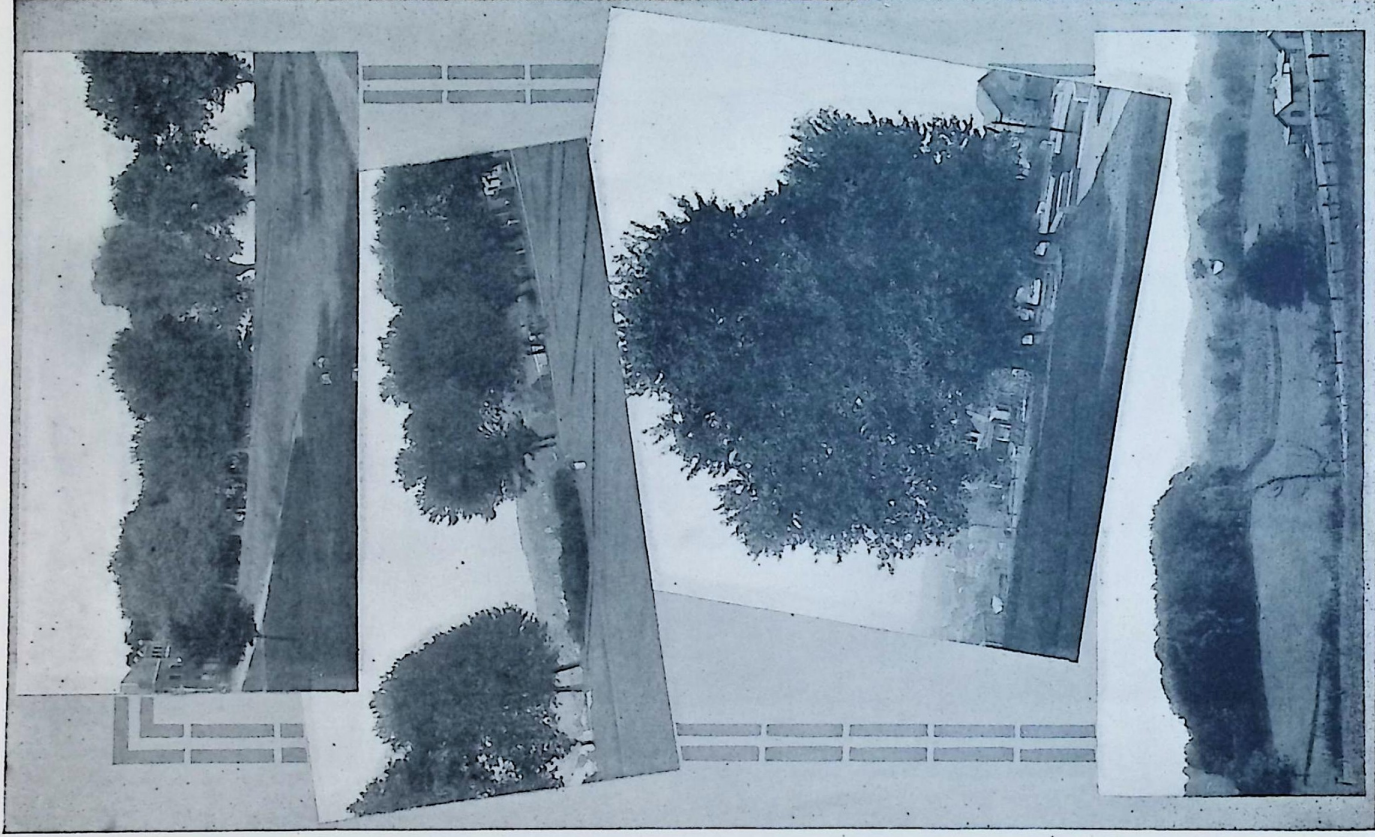

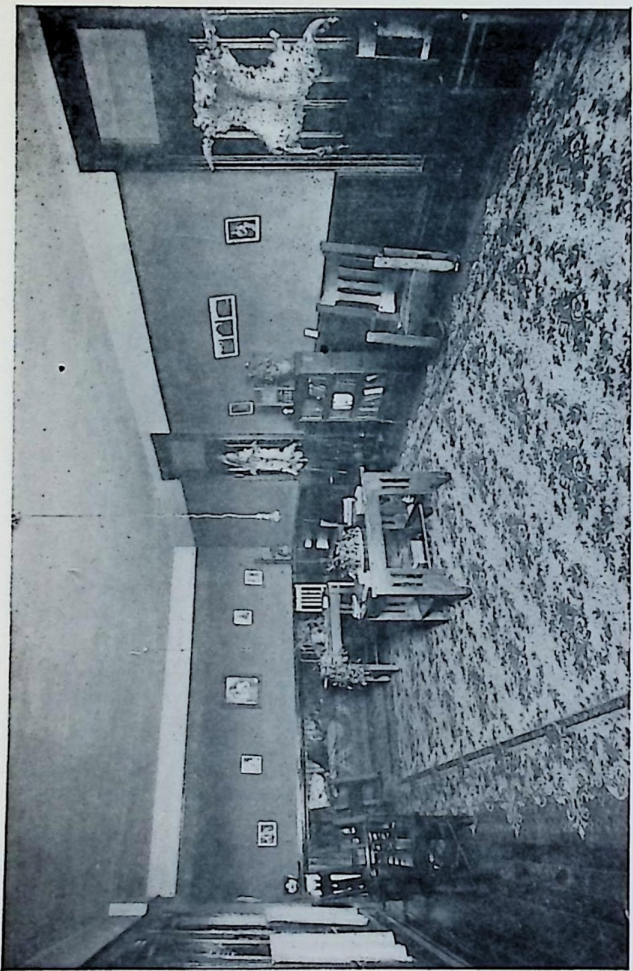

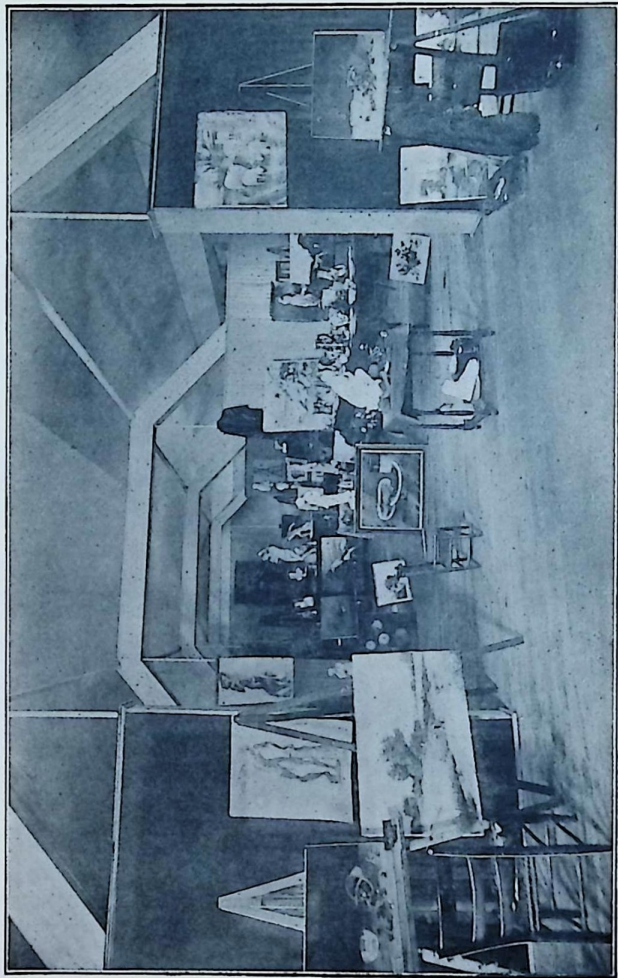

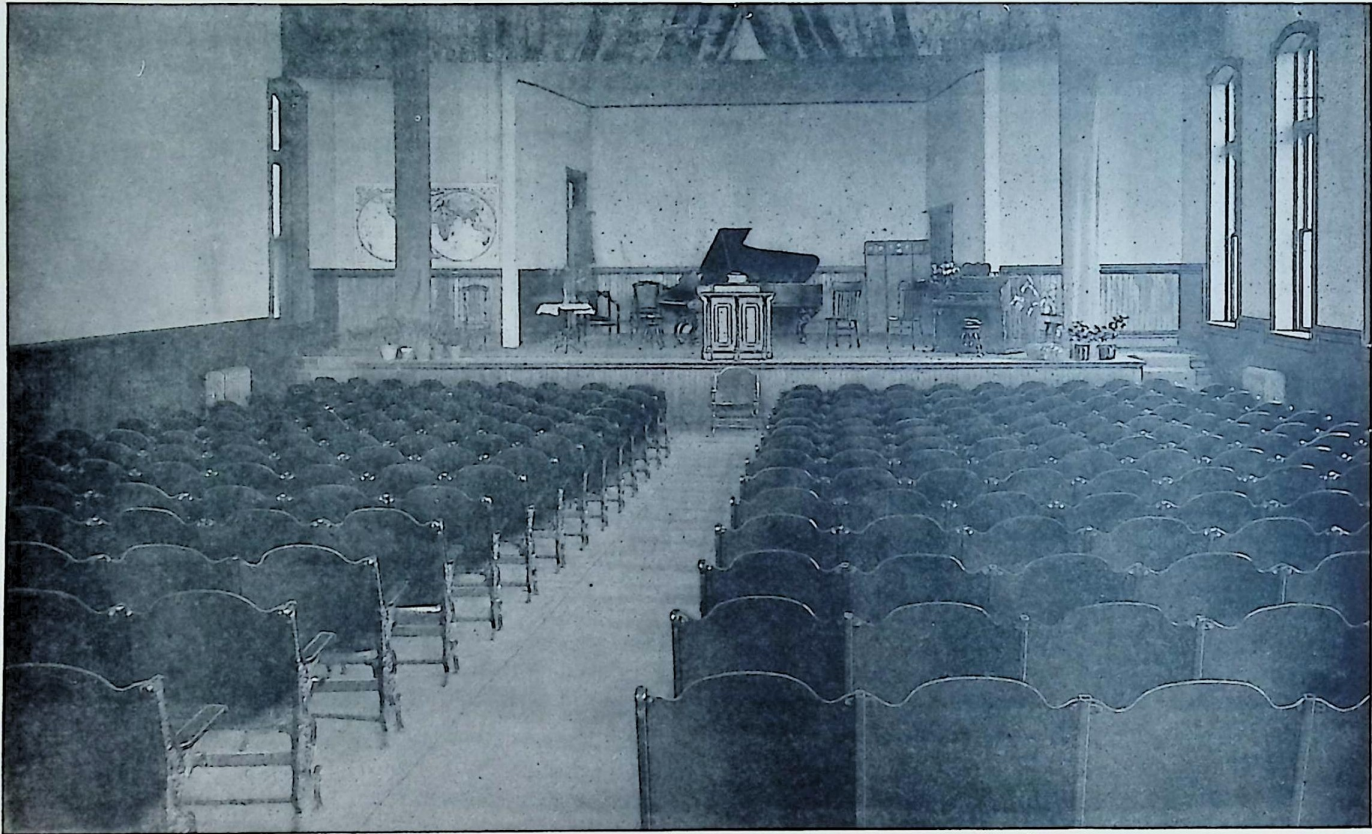

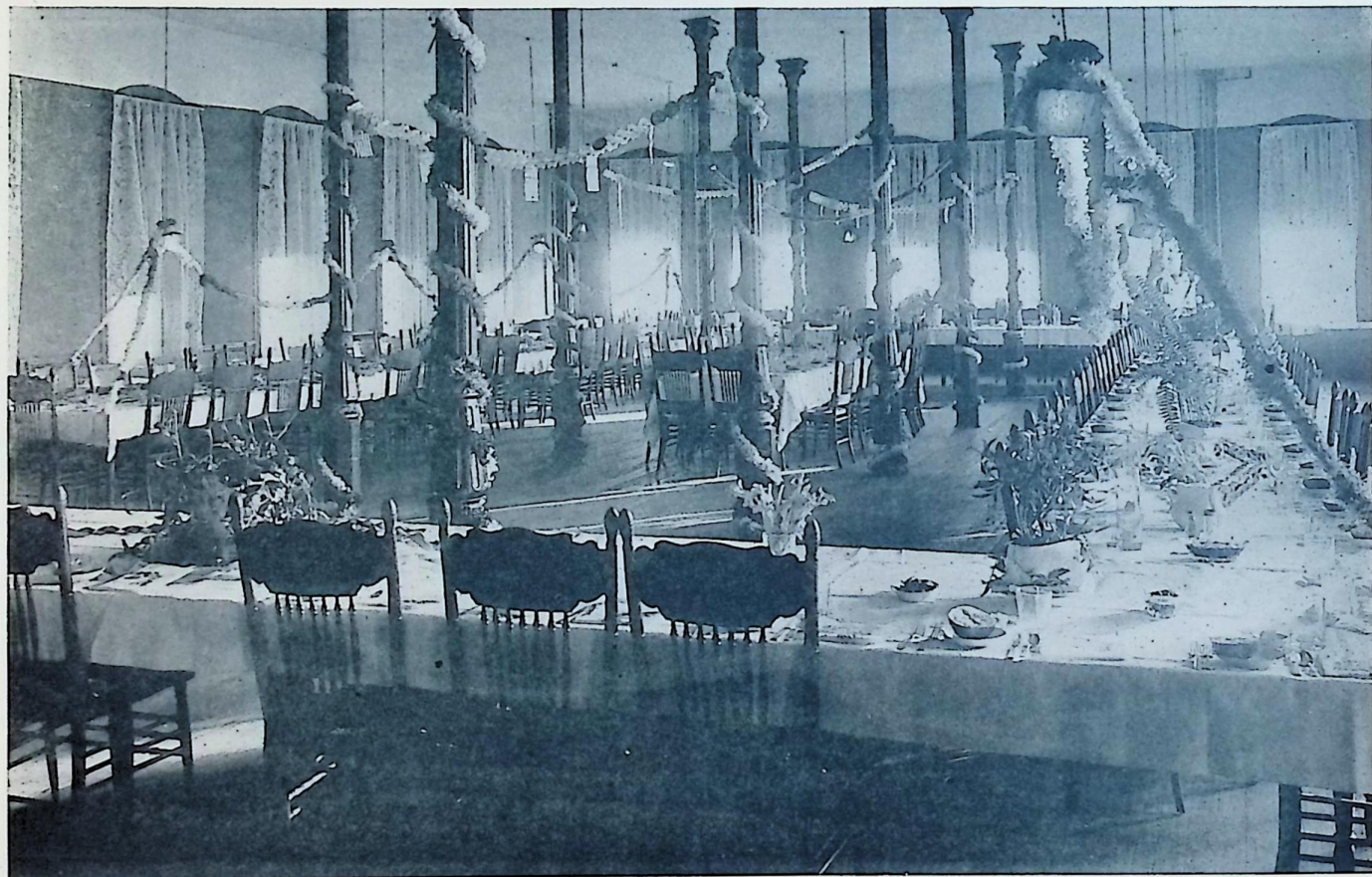

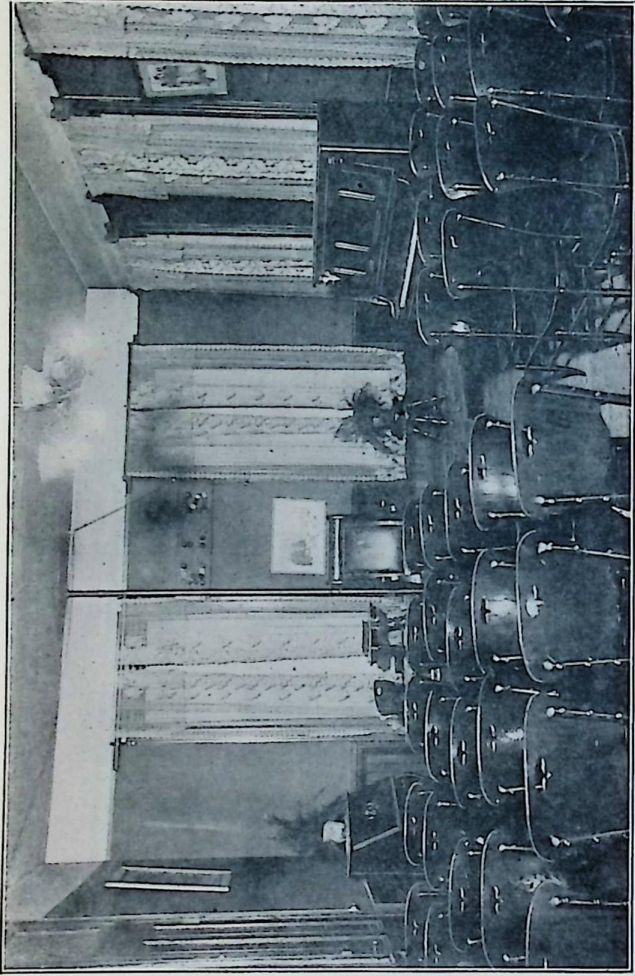

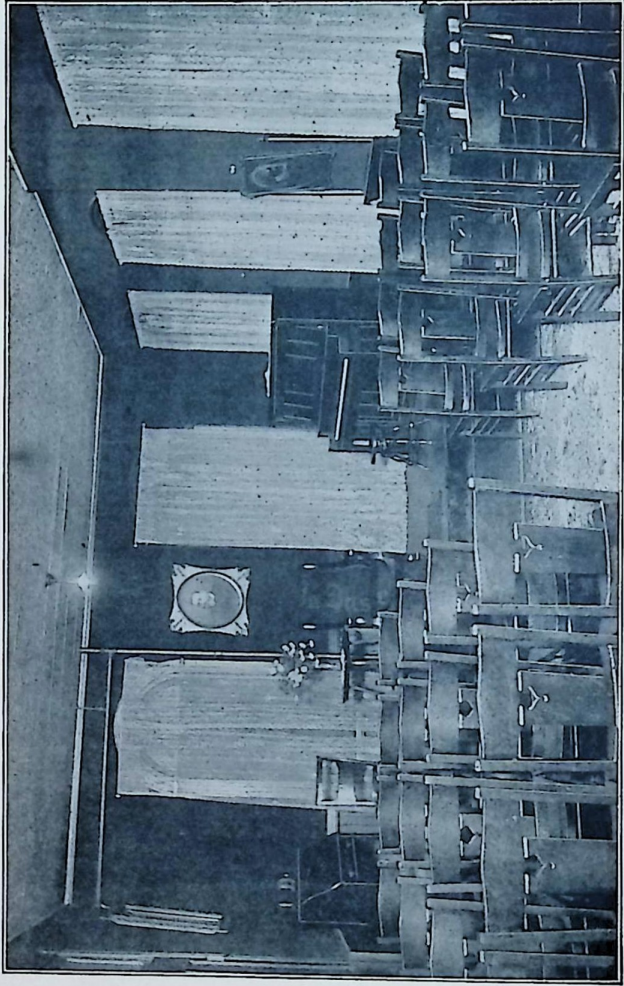

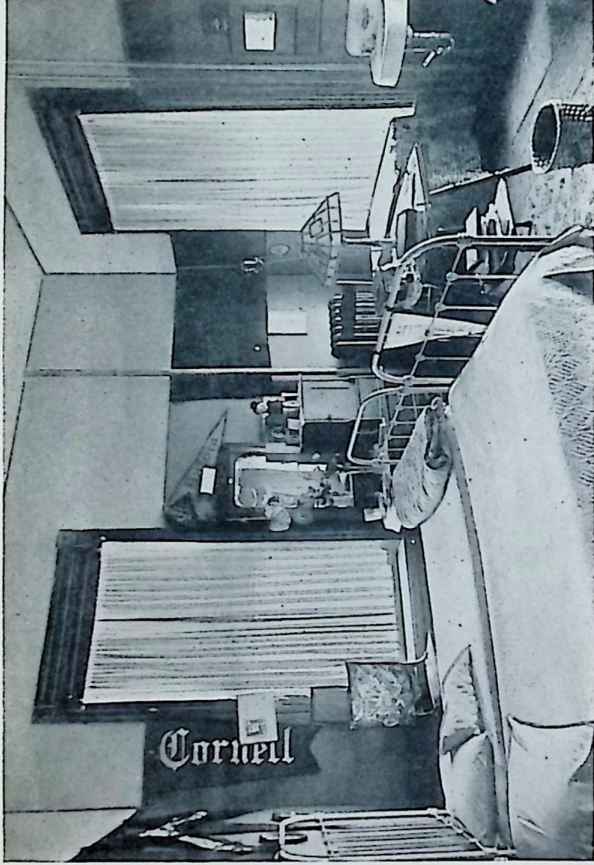

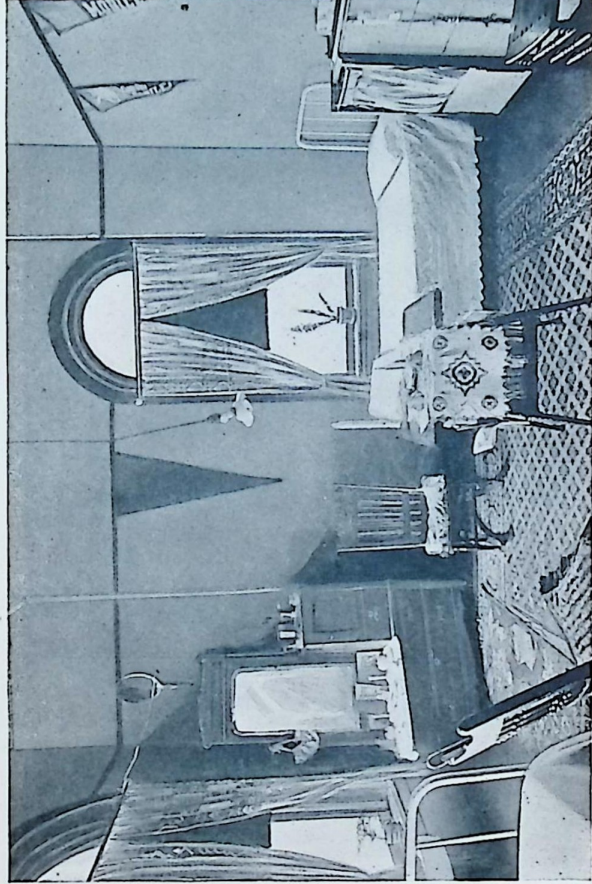

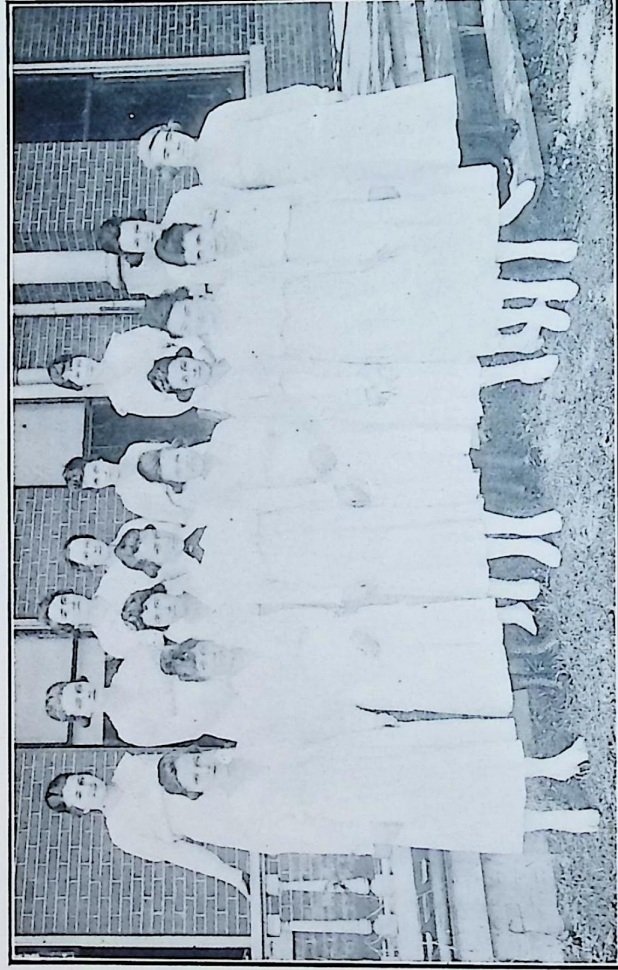

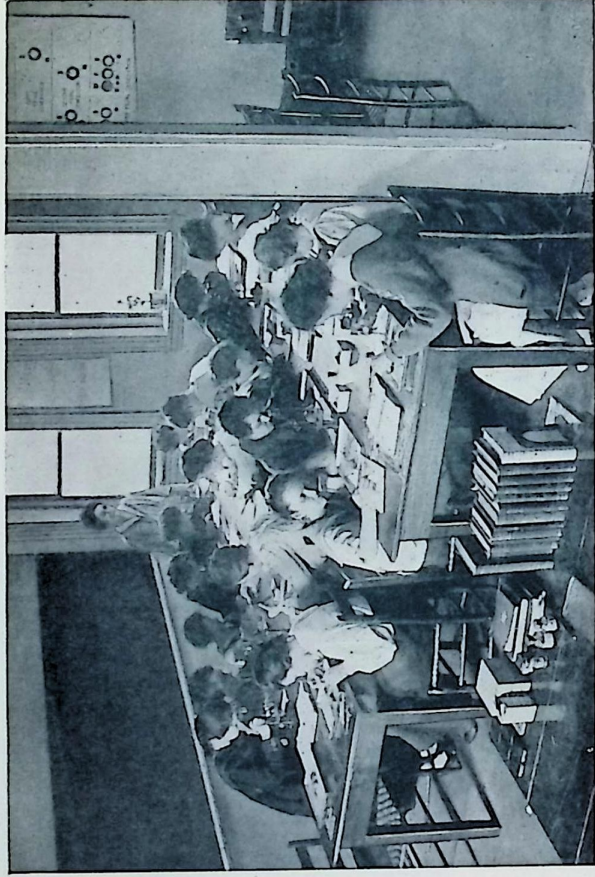

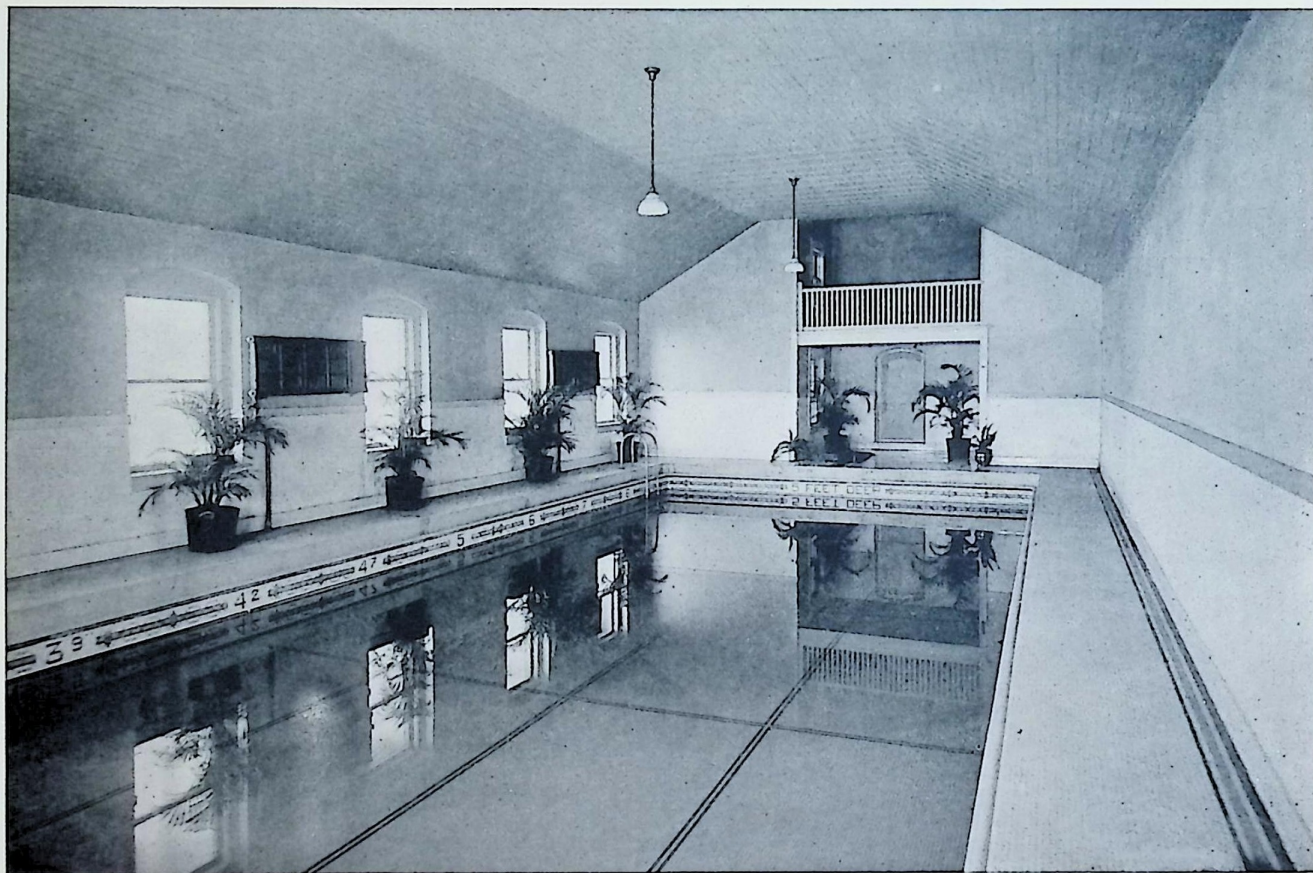

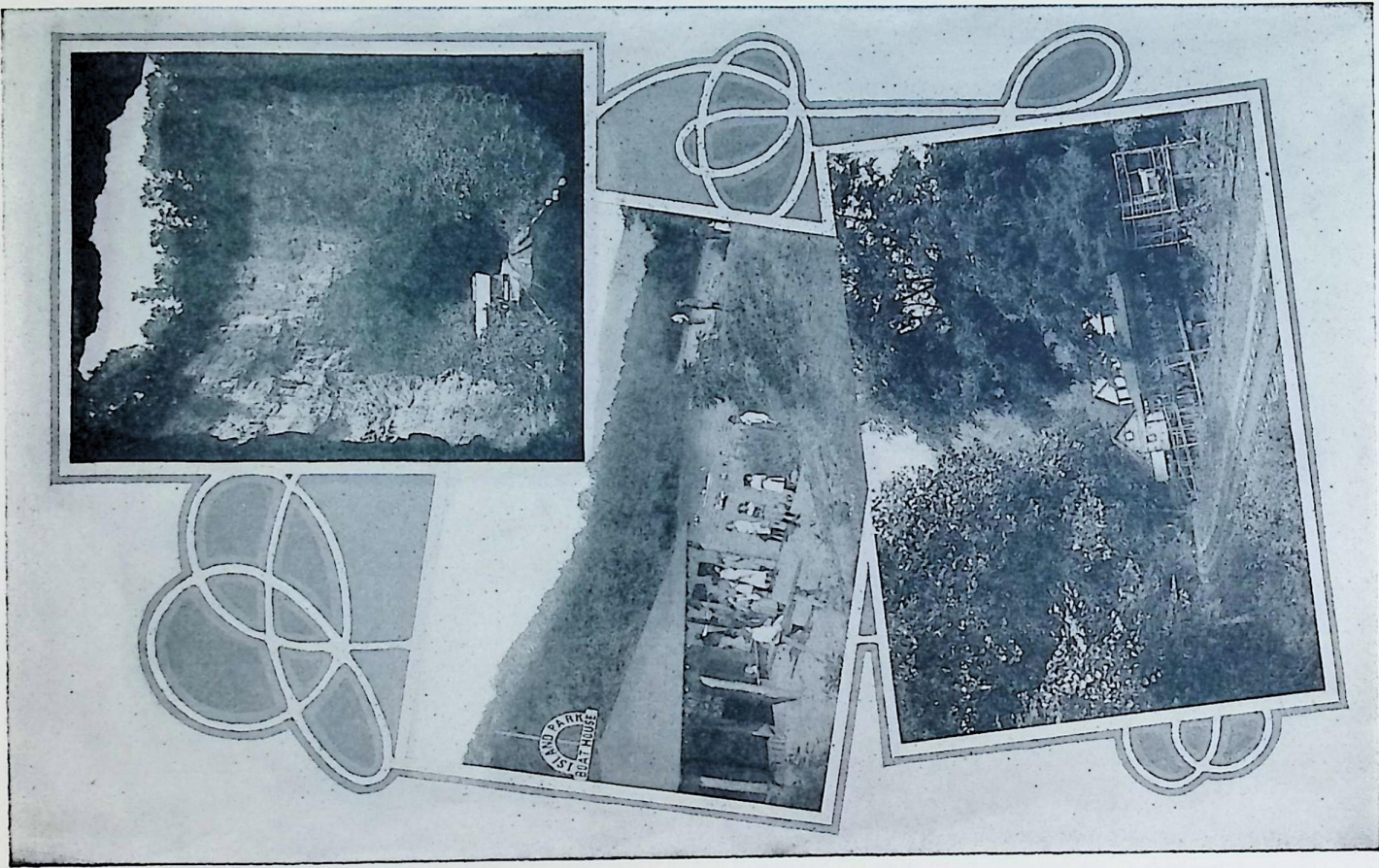

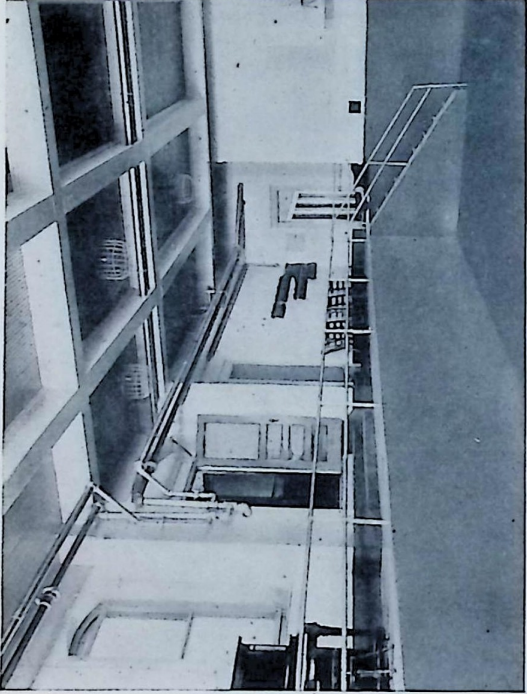

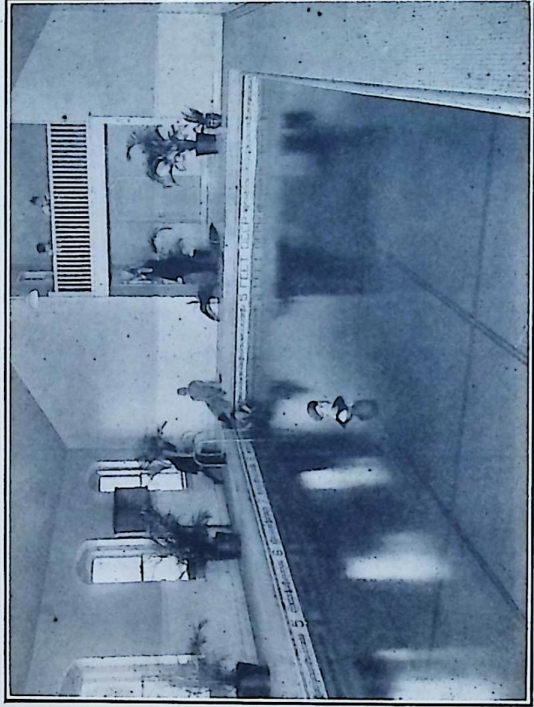
